Boarding Services



Requirements

Extended care is offered to established clients only. If your pet is not an established patient, you may set up an appointment for an "exam for boarding" with one of our veterinarians prior to your pet's stay.

All animals entering our hospital must be current on vaccinations If we did not give the vaccines, proof is necessary by way of certificate or receipt from the veterinarian that administered them. Home or breeder vaccinations are not acceptable. Our hospital can administer vaccinations that are not current at the time of boarding.

Technician and Doctor Supervision

Kennel Assistants are with your pet throughout the day and work closely with a technician who checks on your pet three times daily; they also administer medication. Our veterinarians are available to address any concerns while your pet is boarding. There is no one in our facility overnight.

Required vaccinations for dogs:

□ DA2PP within 12 months
 □ RABIES current per compendium
 □ BORDETELLA within 6 months

Required vaccinations for cats:

FVRCP within 12 months
 RABIES current per compendium
 FIV/FELV within 12 months OR a negative test within 24 months with no history of

Frontline

All animals must be free of external parasites (fleas, ticks, etc.). An application of Frontline Flea and Tick Control is required at the time of admission and will be at the owner's expense. If the owner applies the flea and tick control, the owner must bring the empty vial and not the date applied. The following flea and tick controls are acceptable: Frontline, Advantage, Advantix, Revolution.

Health

We must be made aware of any medical problems your pet may have upon entering extended care. We can administer medication, vitamins, and supplements to your pet for an additional charge. Medicine must be in the original container.

Additional Services

Additional treatments can be administered while boarding, such as physical exams, surgery, dentals, blood work, baths, and pedicures. Baths and pedicures are offered at a 50% discount for boarders. Baths include a complimentary pedicure. Please ask our customer services representatives for pricing.

Food and belongings

Feeding instructions should be provided by the owner. The owner may supply the food or the hospital will feed dogs Purina EN and cats Hills Science Diet Adult maintenance. If no feeding instructions are given, your pet will be fed once in the morning and once at night.

Owners may bring toys, blankets, and beds. We do NOT allow rawhide, bones, or other items that may prevent a hazard. Please remember some pets become destructive during their stay and may destroy their belongings. We take all precautions to prevent this but cannot be responsible for damage that may occur.

Physical Activity

Each dog is taken separately outside, supervised, to the yard at least 5 times a day. Each cat is let out in an enclosed room with supervision.

- Please remember to allow yourself adequate time to fill out paper work at the time of drop off.
- Daycare is available for pets that do not need to stay overnight. All the previous requirement apply to daycare.
- Charges for extended care are based on the weight of your pet. Please ask our customer service representatives for the current rates.
- Oversized facilities are available for a small extra fee.
